Entry Fee: \$600 for 4-person team all inclusive (Non-Members pay discounted guest fee for golf to the Proshop on Sunday before teeing off \$40 each)

Online Registration will begin April 1. Early registration ends June 1st. Late fee of \$100/team will be assessed for entries after June 1 and all late fees will go to Jared512 foundation. We will have a live leaderboard at weigh in and Weighmaster needs headcount! Only way to secure spot is by paying in full. Plan to cut off at 24 teams.

Team Fishing Side Pots for Cash

Fishing Side Pots for Teams. These fish count towards team total. \$100 per team goes to side cash pots for: spot pot, heaviest slot red 20"-28", heaviest trout between 15"-20", heaviest flounder over 15". Money is evenly distributed; all prizes are equal.

RULES

- 1. IN THE EVENT THE TOURNAMENT IS CANCELED, ALL MONEY WILL BE RETURNED TO PARTICIPANTS.**
2. Up to four individuals are allowed on a team. Teams may fish with a guide if they choose, but the guide will not count as one of their team members and is not allowed to fish. If the guide fishes the team is disqualified.
- 3. All passengers on the boat MUST BE REGISTERED IN THE TOURNAMENT. THERE WILL BE NO SPECTATORS OR OTHER PASSENGERS THAT ARE NOT COMPETING IN THE TOURNAMENT ALLOWED ON THE VESSEL.**
- 4. No more than 4 Individuals allowed on a vessel for Teams not using a Guide. No more than 5 Individuals allowed on a vessel for Teams using a Guide.**
- 5. TEAMS MUST DECLARE IF THEY ARE FISHING WITH A GUIDE AT THE CAPTAIN'S MEETING which will start at 7:00pm and provide the captain's name.**
- 6. 1 Boat only per team.**
- 7. Tournament hours are 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Saturday June 27, 2026.**
8. A picture of the fish and *special object* must be taken upon catching a fish that will possibly be entered in the tournament, and this picture must be presented to tournament officials upon request. If picture cannot be presented, fish will not be counted for tournament entry.
- 9. Weigh in will be between 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM, Saturday June 27, 2026 at RiverHills. Anyone not standing in the weigh-in line, with your fish in hand at 6:00 PM, will receive 0 pounds.**
10. Each team will walk up to the weighmaster with only up to 5 fish consisting of: One (1) Redfish (20-28") for Spot Pot category (Redfish must have more than 2 spots to be eligible for entry), One (1) Redfish (20-28") for Heavy Red (same Redfish for Spot Pot can be used for Heavy Red. MUST be declared ahead of time), Two (2) Speckled Trout (15-20"), and One (1) Flounder (15" - No Max).
11. If a fish is undersized, oversized, or deemed illegal, that fish will get 0lbs recorded and no substitution will be allowed.
12. It is the Angler's responsibility to properly select their fish ahead of time. Weighmaster will not choose heavier fish for you. No culling fish at the weigh table.
13. If a fish is kicked or disqualified for any reason, it cannot be replaced with another fish.
14. Before Spot Pot Red is weighed and counted, you must declare to Weighmaster if you plan to use same fish for Heavy Redfish category.

15. All fishing areas must be available to the general public.
16. All fish must be taken by rod and reel only. No cast nets, bow fishing, gigging, etc.
17. 1 pole per angler allowed in the water at a time.
18. All live, dead, or artificial baits are allowed.
19. If wade fishing, teammates must remain within eyesight of each other and boat at all times. **For Teams that are fishing with a Guide, Guide MUST remain in boat at all times.**
20. Fish that are altered, mutilated, not in a fresh or edible condition, or do not comply with TPWD measurement regulations will be disqualified and cannot be substituted with another fish.
21. All fish subject to inspection by weighmaster. All entrants subject to questioning by weighmaster.
22. ALL DECISIONS MADE BY WEIGHMASTER ARE FINAL. ALL FISH WILL BE INSPECTED
23. Each team will start with even par 70 on Saturday and deduct their team stringer weight from that 70 for their final score. **Team stringer consists of One (1) Slot Redfish (20-28"), Two (2) Speckled Trout (15-20"), One (1) Flounder (15" – No Max), no other combinations or fish allowed.** You do not have to have all 4 fish to enter. For Example, if you turn in 8 lbs of fish, $70 - 8 = 62$. That's your score Saturday.
24. Sunday each team will play a 4-person scramble (1 PM Shotgun Start) from the white tees for the men and red tees for women, using USGA recommended handicapping for team handicap will be deducted from their gross score to record their net score. The golf net score from Sunday will be added to Saturday's score, and lowest total score wins.

1st, 2nd, and 3rd places will be paid
