CATEGORIES

\$600 PER TEAM/ 4 MAN TEAM

La Pesca Heaviest Stringer – Heaviest Stringer consisting of (2) Speckled Trout (15-20") and (1) Redfish (20-28")

Heaviest Slot Red – Heaviest Slot Redfish (20-28"). Can not be same fish used in La Pesca Heaviest Stringer

Heaviest Slot Trout - Heaviest Slot Speckled Trout (15-20"). Can not be same fish used in La Pesca Heaviest Stringer

SIDE POTS

\$100 EACH PER TEAM

Heaviest Flounder - Heaviest Flounder (15"-no max) Pays out 50% to 1st place only, with the remaining 50% being donated back to first christian church of alice.

Heaviest Trout - Heaviest slot trout from your heaviest trout entry (\$100 entry). Pays out 50% to 1 st place only, with the remaining 50% being donated back to first christian church of alice.

Heaviest Redfish - Heaviest Redfish - Heaviest slot Redfish (20-28"). Must be same fish used for your Heaviest Redfish entry. Pays out 50% to 1st place only with the remaining 50% being donated

Heaviest Black Drum - Heaviest slot Black Drum(14-30") Pays out 50% to 1st place only, with the remaining 50% being donated back to first christian church of alice.

Spot pot - Spot Pot – Slot Redfish (20-28") with the most spots Redfish must have more than 2 spots to be eligible for consideration in the spot pot. Can be a separate fish from your Heaviest Redfish/La Pesca Stringer

2025 RULES

- 1. All entrants must read and sign waiver stating they understand and follow all rules.
- Up to four individuals are allowed on a team. Teams may fish with a guide if they choose; however, the guie does not count as a team member and is not allowed to contribute fish to the team.
- 3. All fishing areas must be available to the general public.
- 4. You must have a valid saltwater fishing license from towd to fish in this tournament.

 Kids 17 and under not need a license but must be accompanied by an adult at all times
- 5. All texas parks & amp; wildlife laws apply.
- 6. Any entrant cited for a tpwd infraction will be automatically disqualified.
- 7. All fish must be taken by rod and reel only. No cast nets, bow fishing, gigging, etc.
- 8. All live, dead, or artificial bait is allowed.
- 9. All entered fish must be caught during tournament hours. No check-in is required before fishing. Tournament hours are from 6:00 am to 2:00 pm, saturday, April 26 2025
- 10. Kayak and boats will all be allowed to compete in this years event! There will be no separate kayak/boat divisions. All registered teams will be competing in the same division.
- 11. Kayak teams, and boat teams that are wade fishing must remain within eyesight of each other and their vessel at all times throughout tournament hours.
- 12. No fishing outside of the jetties or past the end of the jetties.
- 13. All fish weighed in must have been caught by registered participants. No borrowed fish.
- 14. No holding or blocking off any fishing areas by other individuals not participating in tournament.
- 15. 1 pole per angler allowed in the water at a time.
- 16. In the event of a tie in weight, or number of spots (spot pot) for all categories/ side pots, the team that weighed in first will be the winner.
- 17. No scales or means of measuring will be available from weigh-master or tournament members prior to official weigh in You must choose which fish you are entering into the tournament prior to weighing in the fish you present to the weigh-master is the fish you enter!
- 18. If bait or fish are inside the mouth of the fish when caught, it can remain in the mouth, but it cannot be secured if it falls out at any time (including weigh-in), you may not put it back in
- 19. Weigh-master services will be provided by gulf coast weigh-master services. They are trained to check for freshness of the fish and for any tampering or alterations made to the fish. Any and all decisions of the weigh-master are final.
- 20. Tournament will proceed rain or shine.
- 21. Fish not meeting tpwd rules in measurements will be disqualified and cannot be replaced with another fish.
- 22. You do not have to have a complete stringer to be able to weigh in for heavy stringer category.
- 23. Weigh master has final ruling on all fish related matters.
- 24. No oversized fish allowed in any category.
- 25. The weigh-in will start no earlier than 12 pm and no later than 2 pm at Kaufer hubert memorial park. Anglers will need to be in line with fish in hand by 2 pm. Anyone trying to get in line after 2 pm will be disqualified and not be allowed to weigh in.
- 26. Any and all protests must be submitted, in writing, no later than 15 mins after the last fish is weighed to Tournament Director, with a \$500 cash deposit. If protest is upheld, deposit will be returned to protesting team, if protest is not upheld, deposit will be retained by Tournament. Fish weight cannot be protested. If protesting a length call, fish must remain with Weighmaster immediately following initial measurement.
- 27. All weights recorded by weigh-master are final
